You will have opportunities to visit the main Plaza with the Palace, Cathedral, and colorful market, all of which are begging to be painted. Next a trip to a spa with thermal waters from the volcano you view high above you. A visit to historic Antigua, (one of the most photographed cities in the world) which has Mayan and Spanish ruins on every corner, and is only 40 min. away. For the adventurous, you can climb the volcano on foot or on horseback.

Accommodations - La Casa de la Puerta Pintado

is a private residence in a gated, secure community. La Montana is located on the side of one of many nountains that overlook Guatemala City. Almost every room has a view of the valley that holds the city. Close by is Paseo Cayala an amazing new complex designed in the old colonial style that houses a Cathedral, movie theaters, pharmacy, shopping, and excellent restaurants. La Casa de la Puerta Pintado has 2 bedrooms on the top floor which share a large bath. Both have private palconies, and view of the valley. A third bedroom is located on the second level with a view of the front garden, sharing the 3rd floor bath, but with access to a private half bath. The 4th bedroom in on the ground floor with a private bath. The house has 2 living areas, formal dinning room, large eat-in kitchen, terrace for eating, and beautiful front and back gardens. Studio is adjacent to the house.

Signature Fine Art Gallery, and studied for many years in the US. She has added South and Central America to her resume, most recently Bolivia and Guatemala. She is anxious to teach the new techniques and styles learned in her travels. The flight to Guatemala is usually a direct flight depending on where you are departing from. Most airlines fly here and are reasonably priced. Breakfast each day; some lunches and dinners are included. Pransportation for the tours is included, however meals, snacks, beverages, and cost of activities for tours is not.
